### ICT RESOURCES FOR CHILDREN, PARENTS AND TEACHERS

There are a great many resources now available for teaching and learning of Classical subjects.

The department possesses a good range of software that will be used in lessons and can be accessed by the children from the ICT room and hopefully from the laptops in due course.

#### *Software for use in lessons and for revision:*

- *Roman Africa* (JProgs) - Information and photos on Roman Africa. Includes architecture. There is a photo CD loaded onto the system too.
- *Rome- the Eternal City* (JProgs) - photos, video of all major sites in Rome (ancient and modern). There are many photos stored separately available for use.
- *Roman Life* (JProgs) - sections on Art, Daily Life, Death, Leisure, Public buildings, trade, towns. Quiz at end of each section. Suitable for Yrs 6-8.
- *Roman Britain* (JProgs) - Occupation, Army, Romanisation, Personalities, Hadrian's Wall, Site catalogue. Quiz at end of each section. Fits with Year 5 syllabus but relevant for all year groups.
- *Latin Alive* (JProgs) - Animals and Nature, Historical overview (Aeneas, Romulus and Remus, Monarchy, Republic, Principate), Houses, Map, Numbers, Rome, Words and Phrases. All sections end with a quiz. Relevant for all year groups but probably best fits with year 7 and 8 syllabus.
- *Roman Gods* (JProgs)- Christianity, Eastern Gods, Minor Gods, Myths, Olympians, temples. Final quiz. All year groups.
- *Pompeii* (JProgs) - aspects of the town and information about life there. End of sections quiz. Best for Year 7 and 8. There is a photo CD which is not loaded but can be used separately if collected from the Classics room.
- *Two Greek Myths* (JProgs) - The Odyssey and Theseus in cartoon form with notes. Quiz in two levels after each. Useful for Year 6,7 and 8.
- *Latin Flashdrill* (JProgs) - all Levels of CE grammar in easy to use format for self testing. Years 6-8.
- *Latin Vocab drill* (JProgs) - Level 1-3 of CE vocab for self testing. Tests can be designed individually. Years 6-8.
