<b>GLOBAL</b>			
I can label the 7 continents of the world.			
I can label the following mountain ranges: Alps, Andes, Himalayas, Pyrenees, Rockies			
I can label the Sahra Desert.			
I can label the following oceans: Arctic, Indian, Atlantic, Pacific			
I can label the following rivers: Amazon, Mississippi, Nile, Rhine, Yangtze			
I can label the following parts onto a world map: Arctic Circle, Antarctic Circle, Equator, International Dateline, North Pole, Prime Meridian, South Pole, Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn.			
<b>BRITISH ISLES</b>			
I can name the countries of the UK and Republic of Ireland.			
I can name the seas surrounding the UK: English Channel, Irish Sea, North Sea			
I can name the main rivers of the UK: Severn, Thames, Trent, Clyde, Shannon			
I can name the mountainous areas: Grampians, Lake District, Pennines, Snowdonia			
I can name the major cities: Belfast, Birmingham, Cardiff, Dublin, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Liverpool, London, Manchester, Newcastle.

I can locate the following countries of Europe: France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Poland, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Ukraine.			
I can locate the following countries of Africa: Egypt, Ethiopia,			
I can locate the following countries of the Americas: Brazil, Canada, Mexico, USA			
I can locate the following countries of Asia: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, China, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Japan, Pakistan, Russia, Saudi Arabia.			
I can locate the following countries in Oceania: Australia, New Zealand			
<b>MAJOR CITIES AND CITY STATES</b>			
I can locate the following: Beijing, Berlin, Cairo, Delhi, Los Angeles, Madrid, Mexico City, Moscow, New York, Paris, Rio de Janeiro, Rome, Sydney, Tokyo, Warsaw, Washington DC.
