- 3) One question of the usefulness of sources. (Give it **LIP**) (Limitations, Insight/info, Provenance)

**Section B - ESSAY** Answer **one** (1) essay (split into 2 parts)

Part a) Describe (20 marks)

Part b) Explain (10 marks)

You will be given a selection of 10 essays to choose from. I suggest you revise two of the following topics in depth. **(Do not study King John for the essay!)**

- 1) The Norman Conquest and the Battle of Hastings
- 2) Henry II and Becket
- 3) Black Death
- 4) Peasants' Revolt
- 5) Henry V and Hundred Years War
- 6) A civil war (Stephen and Matilda, Henry III and Simon de Montfort, Wars of the Roses)
