Part A – Evidence

In this section you will be presented with a selection of sources and asked questions about them. You will need to be familiar with the following ideas, and be able to comment on them in relation to a source.

- One-sided/unbalanced views
- Contemporary and Secondary sources
- Fact versus opinion
- Reliability
- Eye witness accounts as opposed to hearsay

Part B – Essay

The second section aims to test your ability to write an essay. You will be given a selection of titles from which you may choose **ONE**. The titles will be based on topics from this year.

When writing your essay, remember the following:

- Structure
- Linking paragraphs
- Backing up your ideas
- Detail – as much as you can
- Quotes?
