From Year 3 onwards, pupils are placed in sets for Mathematics, (usually 3 sets per year group), to ensure that they receive the teaching and encouragement which will lead to steady progress and the overall growth of confidence.

All pupils are regularly assessed and changes are made to setting when this is felt to be appropriate and most beneficial to the individual pupil.

Pupils are prepared for both the Common Entrance, 11+ and 13+ Examinations and those with an exceptional ability, prepare for scholarship papers.



The teaching staff in the Mathematics Department are united in their aim: to ensure that each pupil feels happy and at ease with the subject; finds the work stimulating and is given the opportunity to develop, not only the ability to handle numbers competently and accurately, but also, mental skills and logical in the context of problem solving.
