| 3 | The Bible as a Library | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that the Bible is made up of different books written by different authors and contains writing in different genres To reflect on what the Christians mean by the Bible being 'The Word of God' |
| 4 | The Journey of Life | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To reflect on the journey of life - the highs and lows To explore the register of emotions that human beings experience |
| 5 | Exploring the Psalms | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To understand how Christians use the Bible To explore the Psalms and how they reflect the full range of human emotions |
| 6 | Joseph - Family Life | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know the story of Joseph and its significance for Jews and Christians To gain an understanding of how this relates to life today |
| 7&8 | The Gospels | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that there are 4 gospels and that Christians believe they tell the good news of Jesus Explore the teaching of the gospels and Christian values |
| 9 | The Bible as Wisdom | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To learn about the importance of the Bible to a Christian To identify inspiring words from the Bible through own research |
