	Lesson	Learning Objectives
1	<i>Miracles</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss 3 definitions of the word ‘miracle’ and explore examples of modern day miracles • Gain a knowledge of what happened in the miracles of the healing of the paralysed man and the woman healed on the Sabbath and what it shows about Jesus
2	<i>Parables</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss and gain an understanding of the meaning of parable of the Good Samaritan • Explore the concept of who is my neighbour
3	<i>Parables (2)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss and gain an understanding of the meaning of parable of the Lost Son and the Sower
4	<i>Identity of Jesus</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gain a knowledge of the Transfiguration and an understanding of Peter’s response • Reflect on the identity of Jesus
5	<i>Trial, Crucifixion and death of Jesus</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gain a knowledge of why Jesus was arrested, put on trial and sentenced to death • Discuss and understand what Christians believe these events show about Jesus
6	<i>Resurrection</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gain a knowledge about what the Bible reports happened after Jesus died • Explore other possible explanations for what happened • Review Salvador Dali’s interpretation of the crucifixion & resurrection and the Christian beliefs represented in the paintings
7	<i>Revision Life of the Buddha</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revise the early life, quest and enlightenment of Prince Siddhartha • Revise the Buddha’s Dharma - 4 Noble/8 Steps/5 Precepts
8	<i>Types of Buddhism</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand that there are several denominations of Buddhism; their commonalities and differences
9	<i>Sangha & 3 Refuges</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gain a knowledge of the Sangha and Three Refuges and their significance to modern Buddhists.
10	<i>Buddhist Shrine</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gain an understanding of the Buddhist Shrine as a place of worship and the symbolism of what is found inside a shrine •
