**Lt Richard Palmer, a Feltonfleet Former Pupil,
was killed on active service in Iraq,
15th April 2006, 5 years ago, aged 26**

"Individuals such as Richard have made a tangible difference to the future of the people of Iraq. On a daily basis they put their lives at risk as they endeavour to improve the security situation within the country. He will be sorely missed by all those who knew him and we will ensure that his life has not been sacrificed in vain. Our thoughts are with his family and friends; The Regiment has lost a great ambassador, a splendid soldier and a fine friend. We count ourselves as fortunate to have served with such a man. We will remember him."
